1. I think I told you on the telephone that Bergsdorff had told me that he intended to act on your suggestion of a talk in the margins of the Anglo-German Summit on 2 November (your letter to me of 28 September).

2. Following the cancellation of the Summit, I spoke to Bergsdorff again this morning. I told him (which he did not know) that the new date for the Summit was not until 18 January 1985 and asked whether he would be interested in your other suggestion for a talk in London. He said that this would be nice, but everyone close to Kohl was going to be simply too busy for some time to come. (I can believe this.) So it was left that he would hope to catch you and/or Robin Butler on 18 January.
