1. FOLLOWING IS TEXT OF STATEMENT ISSUED YESTERDAY ON BEHALF OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE EPISCOPAL CONFERENCE OF IRELAND:

"'SIXTEEN YEARS OF VIOLENCE HAVE BROUGHT MUCH TRIBULATION AND HEARTBREAK TO BOTH PROTESTANT AND CATHOLIC COMMUNITIES IN NORTHERN IRELAND. THERE IS IN BOTH COMMUNITIES A GREAT AND WIDESPREAD LONGING FOR AN END TO THE TROUBLES. IT IS OUR SINCERE HOPE THAT THE ANGLO-IRISH AGREEMENT WILL MAKE A GENUINE CONTRIBUTION TOWARD RECONCILIATION. WE ASK OUR PEOPLE TO CONTINUE THEIR PRAYERS FOR PEACE''.
