### IRISH OPINION POLL

SUMMARY

1. AN OPINION POLL SHOWS 2-1 IN FAVOUR OF THE ANGLO-PRISH AGREEMENT. THE OPPOSITION'S LEAD OVER THE COALITION PARTIES HAS BEEN CUT BACK TO 8%, AND DR FITZGERALD IS AHEAD OF MR HAUGHEY FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE JULY 1984.

#### DETAIL

2. AN TRISH TIMES/MRB+ POLL CONDUCTED ON 19/20 NOVEMBER INCLUDED QUESTIONS ON THE ANGLO-IRISH AGREEMENT, ON SATISFACTION WITH THE GOVERNMENT AND ON VOTING PREFERENCES.

#### ANGLO-IRISH AGREEMENT

3. THE FIRST QUESTION ASKED FOR REACTIONS TO THE AGREEMENT:

AND 43% OF FRANNA FARL WERE BROADLY IN FAVOUR OF THE AGREEMENT.

HAT IS INTERESTING THAT MR HAUGHEY GETS RATHER MORE SUPPORT THAN THE AGREEMENT INTSELF (PARA 3), BUT THIS IS EXPLAINED BY RELUCTANCE AMONG HIS SUPPORTERS TO CONDEMN HIM. A BREAKDOWN BY PARTY SHOWS THAT BOW OF FINE GAEL, 69% OF LABOUR, BUT ONLY 34% OF FIANNA FAIL SUPPORTERS DISAGREED WITH HIS POSITION. AMONG FIANNA FAIL SUPPORTERS A MAJORITY (52%) AGREED WITH HIS STAND.
